

**NOTICE FOR BIDS
FOR
NONANNA WELL HOUSE FILTRATION MODIFICATIONS
COLONIAL PINE HILLS SANITARY DISTRICT
PENNINGTON COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA**

Sealed bids will be received by the Board of Trustees, Colonial Pine Hills Sanitary District, Pennington County, South Dakota, until 10:00 A.M., MDT, Tuesday, April 21, 2009, at the office of CETEC Engineering Services, Inc., 1560 Concourse Drive, Rapid City, SD 57703, and will be publicly opened and read for "Nonanna Well House Filtration Modifications", Colonial Pine Hills Sanitary District, Pennington County, South Dakota. All proposals shall be made on the forms furnished by the Owner.

Plans and specifications may be obtained from CETEC Engineering Services, 1560 Concourse Drive, Rapid City, South Dakota 57703, on April 7, 2009. No payment or cash deposit for plans and specifications is required. Unsuccessful bidders shall return plans and specifications to CETEC Engineering Services, Inc.

Each bid envelope shall contain one Bid Proposal only and shall be marked with the words, "Sealed Bid – Nonanna Well House Filtration Modifications, Colonial Pine Hills Sanitary District, Pennington County, South Dakota".

The principal items of work for this project are as follows:

Modifications to existing 3" and 4" ductile iron mechanical well house piping, valves, fittings, and installation of water filtration units. The work also includes underground installation of 375 linear feet of 10" PVC water main, 240 linear feet of 4" PVC drain piping, septic tank, restoration, and related work. The Owner will furnish the water filtration units for installation by the Contractor. The electrical and telemetry work will be completed by the Owner's Contractor.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or a bank draft drawn on a State or National Bank for five percent (5%) of the amount bid, payable to the Colonial Pine Hills Sanitary District or in lieu thereof, a bid bond for ten percent (10%) of the amount bid by a surety authorized to do business in the State of South Dakota, payable to the Colonial Pine Hills Sanitary District, as a guarantee of the bidder entering into a Contract with the Colonial Pine Hills Sanitary District for the Nonanna Well House Filtration Modifications. The checks of all unsuccessful bidders will be returned within thirty (30) days after the bids have been opened.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities and to accept the bid that is to the advantage of and is in the best interest of the Colonial Pine Hills Sanitary District. The Contractor must hold a current South Dakota state license as a "sewer and water plumbing installer" per ARSD 20:53:06, or a "plumbing license" per SDCL 36-25. The Contractor shall be able to demonstrate that he has successfully completed municipal utility work of a similar nature and scope as that required for the project.
