A1.1	Page GP-6 of the General Provisions of the contract was inadvertently omitted from some of the specification books. A new Page GP-6 is included with this addendum.
A1.2	<p>Bid Specifications, Appendix A.</p> <p>A complete Rain Drop Products Installation and Operation Manual is not included in the appendix. Partial product data is included in the appendix. The entire product O&M manual is available for viewing on the CETEC website (www.cetecengineering.com). Click on the "Bidding" tab, then the project, then "Appendix A" next to "Bid Specifications". Prospective Contractors may obtain a bound copy of the Installation and Operations Manual by contacting CETEC Engineering at 605-341-7800.</p>
A1.3	<p>Plan Sheet C-1.</p> <p>The drawing shows a 2" copper line from the control enclosure to the irrigation system connection location about 30' north of the enclosure. Per the second paragraph of Note 5, this pipe shall be <u>Schedule 40 PVC</u> in lieu of copper.</p>

A1.4 Plan Sheet C-1.

Add the following note to the stop and waste curb stop on the 2" water service pipe.
"Embed 2" stop and waste curb stop in 3 c.f. of clean gravel for drainage".


A1.5 Plan Sheet C-4.

Add the following Note 10.

10. Valve Box Adjustment.

The City Water Department will make necessary adjustments to valve box elevations in concrete replacement areas.

GP-15 INSURANCE

The Contractor shall not commence work under this contract until he has obtained all the insurance required under this paragraph and such insurance has been approved by the Owner, nor shall the Contractor allow any subcontractor to commence work on his subcontract until the insurance required of the subcontractor has been so obtained and approved. Each contractor and subcontractor shall maintain for the life of the contract, Workmen's Compensation, Public Liability and Property Damage and Automobile and Truck Insurance, as will protect him from all claims which may arise from operations under this Contract, whether such operations be by himself or by any subcontractor of any one directly or indirectly employed by either of them and also against any special hazard which may be encountered in the performance of this contract according to the following requirements.

(a) WORKMAN'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE

The Contractor shall maintain such insurance for the life of the Contract as will protect himself and the City from claims under Workmen's Compensation Acts.

(b) PUBLIC LIABILITY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE

The Contractor shall maintain for the life of the contract Public Liability and Property Damage Insurance with minimum limits of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence with a \$2,000,000 aggregate limit.

- (1) Grading of land, excavation, borrowing, filling, backfilling, tunneling, pile driving, cofferdam work or caisson work, or
- (2) Moving, shoring, underpinning, razing or demolition of any building or structure, or removal or rebuilding of any structural support thereof.
- (3) Injury to, or destruction of wires, conduits, conduits, pipes or mains, sewers or other similar property, or any apparatus in connection therewith below the surface of the ground, if such injury or destruction is caused by, or occurs during the use of mechanical equipment for the purpose of grading of land, paving, excavating or drilling, or
- (4) Injury to, or destruction of, public or private property at any time resulting therefrom including paint damage.
- (5) The Property Damage Liability Insurance shall include coverage for injury to, or destruction of, any property arising out of blasting or explosion.
