

Invitation to Bid

Sealed bids will be received by the Department of Game, Fish and Parks Engineering Section, at the office of CETEC Engineering Services, Inc., 1560 Concourse Drive, Rapid City, South Dakota 57703 until 10:00 AM MDT, September 15, 2009, for labor and materials for Legion Lake Campground Road Construction and Utility Relocation in Custer County, South Dakota.

Copies of the Plans and Specifications are on file at, and may be requested from, CETEC Engineering Services, Inc., 1560 Concourse Drive, Rapid City, South Dakota 57703, phone (605)341-7800.

The scope of work includes reconstruction of 22 camping pads at Legion Lake Campground located within Custer State Park. Primary work includes grading, process in-place reclamation, base course, asphalt paving, concrete sidewalks and pads, water main, sewer main, utilities, erosion control and site restoration.

With bids of \$100,000.00 or more, bidders will be required to submit a Contractor's Statement of Skills and Capabilities questionnaire provided by the Department of Game, Fish and Parks and included herewith in the Project Manual. This questionnaire shall be completed and submitted prior to or at the time of the bid opening.

Each bid in excess of \$50,000.00 must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or draft in the amount of 5% of the base bid and all add alternates and drawn on a State or National Bank or a 10% bid bond issued by a surety authorized to do business in the State of South Dakota and made payable to the Department of Game, Fish and Parks of the State of South Dakota.

Anyone requesting, reviewing, or copying plans and specifications for this project (such individual is hereinafter referred to as "bidder") agrees that they are doing so for the sole purpose of submitting a bid on the project. In consideration of the State of South Dakota providing such plans and specifications for the purpose of preparing a bid, bidder agrees that any copies of the plans and specifications obtained directly from the State will be returned to the State immediately after the State provides notice that bidder will not be awarded a contract, or thirty (30) days after the bid opening for the project, which ever occurs first.

Should bidder be awarded a contract for construction of the project, bidder does not need to return plans and specifications until after completion of the project.

The South Dakota Department of Game, Fish and Parks reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities therein.
