

NOTICE FOR BIDS
for
Marshall Street Water Main Replacement
City Of Sturgis Municipal Utility Board, South Dakota

Sealed bids will be received by the City Municipal Utility Board Water Superintendant, City of Sturgis, South Dakota, until 2:00 P.M., MDT Thursday, April 7, 2011, at the office of the City of Sturgis Municipal Utility Board, 1040 2nd Street, Sturgis, SD 57785, and will be publicly opened and read for "Marshall Street Water Main Replacement", City of Sturgis, South Dakota. All proposals shall be made on the forms furnished by the Owner.

Plans and specifications may be obtained from CETEC Engineering Services, 1560 Concourse Drive, Rapid City, South Dakota 57703, on or about March 18, 2011. A refundable plans deposit of \$25 is required for all bidders located outside of South Dakota. All unsuccessful bidders shall return plans and specifications to CETEC Engineering Services, Inc.

Each bid envelope shall contain one Bid Proposal only and shall be marked with the words, "Sealed Bid – Marshall Street Water Main Replacement, City of Sturgis Municipal Utility Board, South Dakota."

The project includes approximately 410 LF 8" PVC Water Main, 215 TON Base Course, and 193 TON Asphalt Concrete Composite among other materials to complete the water main replacement along Marshall Street between Fulton Street and Davenport Street within the City of Sturgis, South Dakota.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or a bank draft drawn on a State or National Bank for five percent (5%) of the amount bid, payable to the City of Sturgis Municipal Utility Board or in lieu thereof, a bid bond for ten percent (10%) of the amount bid by a surety authorized to do business in the State of South Dakota, payable to the City of Sturgis Municipal Utility Board, as a guarantee of the bidder entering into a Contract with the City of Sturgis Municipal Utility Board for the Marshall Street Water Main Replacement project. The checks of all unsuccessful bidders will be returned within thirty (30) days after the bids have been opened.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities and to accept the bid that is to the advantage of and is in the best interest of the City of Sturgis Municipal Utility Board. The Contractor shall be able to demonstrate that he has successfully completed municipal water main and street work of a similar nature and scope as that required for the project.
